7- <u>DEMOGRAPHICS 2021-2022</u> – In 2021-2022 we opened 56 new files for people in need of assistance. This represents 89 adults and 61 children. Among these, a total of 12 were single-parent families who were responsible for 19 children in total.

We have seen an increase in different classes of refugee families, 14 in total (more than double last year's) However, there are some who have been in Canada for 2-3 years. Many have come from Cameroon where there is conflict now. So far, we have opened files to assist 3 Ukrainian settler families. We expect to open more throughout 2022-2023. Again, as in the past, a large portion of families served represent those who were recent immigrants with 64% of new families.

20 countries are represented among those files that were opened for this period. Some countries that we had not seen as much in the past include, (besides Ukraine) Philippines, China, Burundi, Cameroon, El Salvador, and the Dominican Republic.

Agape still serves clients who opened files for assistance in previous years and the average ranges from 20 food orders per month, including basic non-perishable food items and frozen bread and pastries. Some families request help 2-3 times per month.
