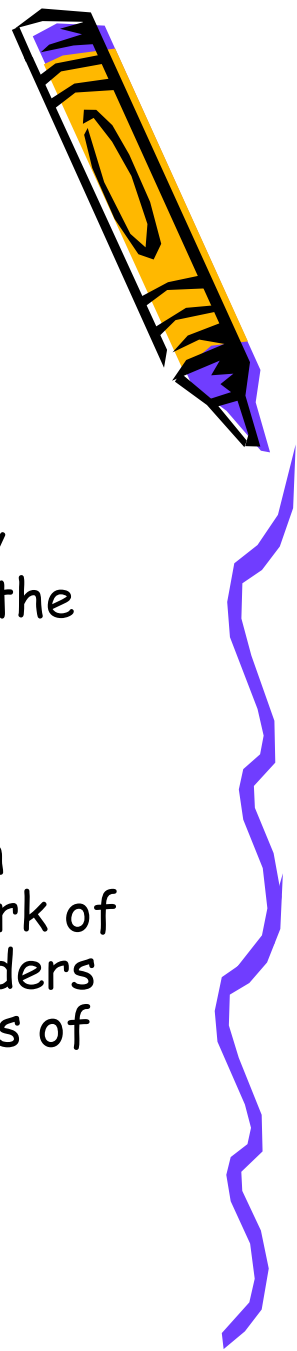

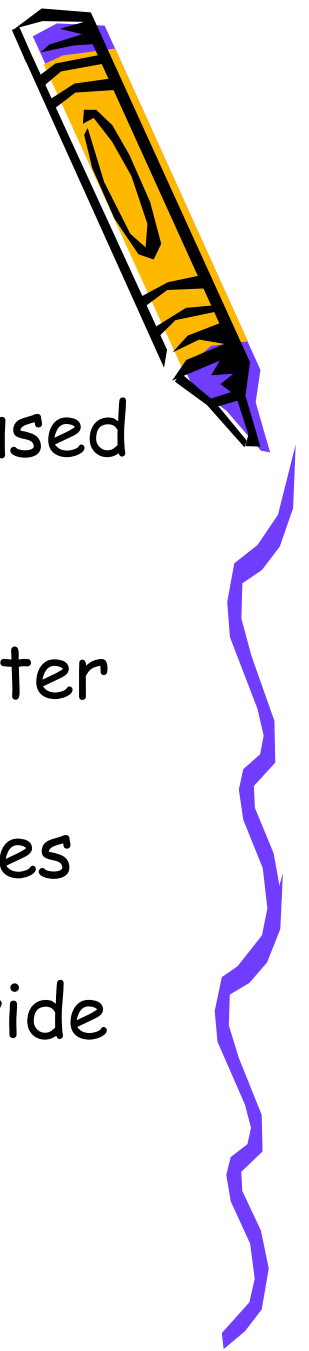
St. Paul's School CLC Partnership Table

From Vision to Reality the CARS Process

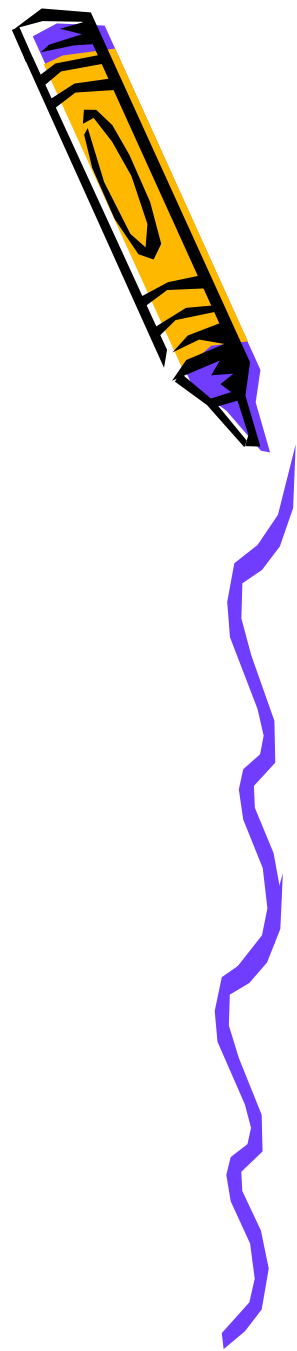


- Municipalities-management of salaries, insurance for after hours school usage, grants, etc...

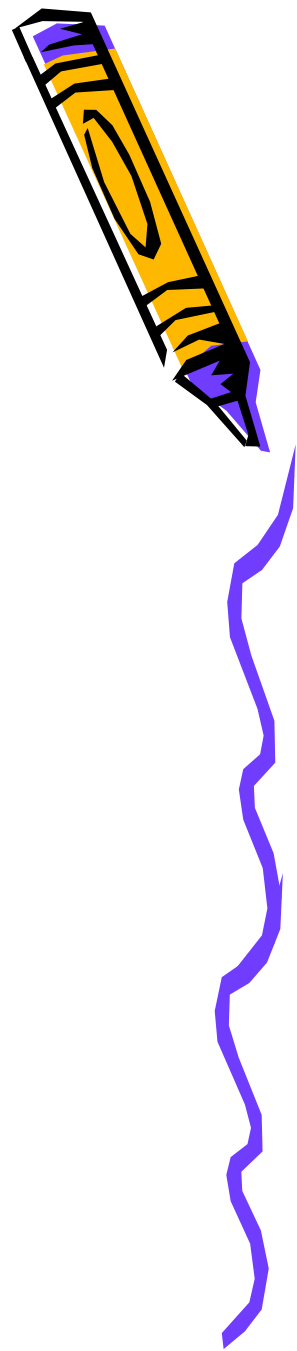

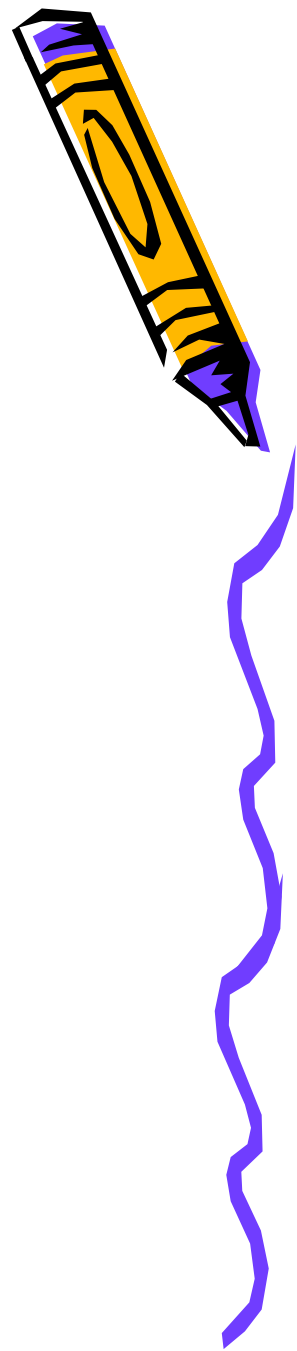

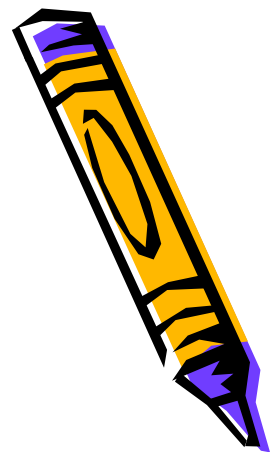
