What is a collective garden?

A collective garden means neighbors come to the garden on the same day and take care of the garden together. They share the work in the garden (planting, watering, cleaning, etc.) and they also share the harvest, so everyone gets some of the food! There is a garden facilitator who comes to each garden session. Their job is to help organize the sessions and share knowledge about growing vegetables (including how and when to plant, how to apply fertilizer, what to do about bugs, and more).

About the Westhaven collective garden:

This garden was created in 2014 and is managed by the NDG Food Depot. The Food Depot pays for all the materials needed to run the garden (including seeds, plants, fertilizer, tools, etc.) and also hires the garden facilitator for the garden. Gardeners don't need to pay for any of these things! Gardeners decide together what kinds of things they want to grow in the garden. Children are always welcome in the garden.

When does the garden in Westhaven start?

Garden sessions will be on **Saturdays, from 2pm – 5pm**

Garden start (first day): Saturday, April 23rd

Garden end (last day): Saturday, October 22nd



How much does it cost to join the garden? There is a membership fee to join the garden. This fee helps the Food Depot buy materials and plants for the garden. The membership fee is \$40 per family. If you cannot afford the membership we have reduced rates! Please ask us!
