
The Impact of Support on the Mental Health of LGBTQIA2S+ Youth across Québec

Y4Y Québec and Connexions Resource Centre partnered up to hold the First Annual Pontiac Pride event to celebrate the LGBTQIA2S+ youth of the region, and their families, allies, & friends. The youth consultation Y4Y conducted during the event brought a range of experiences to light.
