





The YES Mentorship Program aims to facilitate the conveying of skills, knowledge and wisdom from an experienced professional (a mentor) to a less-experienced individual (a mentee). A mentor acts as a guide, a role model and as an advisor to a mentee, who is willing to learn from their mentor's experiences in order to develop their career or business. 




