The entrepreneurship program offers workshops, one-on-one business coaching, a legal information clinic, mentoring, grants & loans, an extensive resource library and referrals to the YES Legal Team and the YES Accounting Team, who offer services at preferential rates. In addition, "The Montreal Entrepreneur's Guidebook", a comprehensive resource guide published by YES, is available for purchase at our centre. YES also hosts an annual entrepreneurship conference, the largest Englishlanguage event of its kind in Quebec, which is held each spring.

Artists Program

OPEN TO ARTISTS OF ALL AGES AND DISCIPLINES. The YES Artists Program offers workshops, employment counselling, business coaching, information on artist grants and an annual conference, "Business Skills for Creative Souls". This essential handbook for artists is available for purchase at the YES centre.

Registration Information

Our daytime workshops are available on a drop-in basis or by pre-registration. Pre-registration is mandatory for all evening workshops. 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Mentorship Program

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THE YES MENTORSHIP PROGRAMS facilitates the passing on of skills, knowledge and wisdom from an experienced individual (a mentor) to a less experienced individual (a mentee). A mentor acts as a guide, a role model and an advisor for a mentee, who is willing to learn from their mentor's experiences in order to develop his/her career or business. The development of a successful mentoring relationship requires an investment of time, the ability to be open and honest, and a commitment to personal development and learning.

The YES Career Mentorship Program facilitates youth career development and employment in Quebec. Mentees are matched with experienced professionals who can provide support, guidance and encouragement. Career mentees work toward achieving specific career goals that they establish at the start of the relationship.

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To qualify for the YES Career Mentorship Program, candidates must:

- Meet with a YES Job Search Counsellor to determine eligibility
- Be job-ready through education and/or experience or be in the first 3 years of an established career
- Not be returning to school full-time in the near future

Career mentees and mentors must commit to meeting in person at least once a month for a period of six months.

The YES Entrepreneurship Mentorship Program aims to increase the success rate of start-up entrepreneurs by providing them access to the knowledge and expertise they need to make good business decisions on their own. Novice entrepreneurs are matched with experienced business people who can provide support, guidance and encouragement. Entrepreneurship mentees work toward achieving specific business goals that they establish at the start of the relationship.

To qualify for the YES Entrepreneurship Mentorship Program, candidates must:

- Have a mentorship assessment through the business coaching services to determine eligibility
- 7 Have an existing business for which they work full-time
- 7 Have a business that has been in operation for less than five years

Entrepreneurship mentees and mentors must commit to meeting in person at least once a month for a period of one year.
