ANSWER OUR CALL



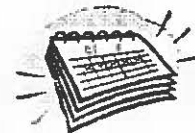
Once again, the Coaster Association have launched an extensive membership campaign, both on and off the coast. We are looking forward to renewed and new membership to answer our call and join our team.

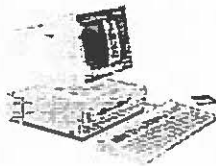
