## Your Starting Point For Legal Information

Can you install a video camera in a Senior's CHSLD room? Since the covid-19 crisis began, some seniors living in residential and long-term care centres (CHSLDs) have suffered mistreatment, neglect, or abuse. Many family members have felt isolated from their loved ones. Did you know that the law allows family members to install a video camera in their loved one's room? There are certain rules that must be respected though. The CHSLD must inform residents or family members about the rules and provide support to respect them. ## CHAUDIERE-APPALACHES IN "RED ZONE"

To slow the spread of COVID-19, the following economic activities must cease starting October 1, 2020 in the Chaudière-Appalaches (<u>Red zone Maximum Alert</u>):

- restaurants and food courts in shopping centres and food stores, except for deliveries, take-outs or drive-through orders;
- bars and discotheques;
- microbreweries and distilleries, only for their services for consumption of food or beverages on the premises;
- museums, biodomes, planetariums, insectariums, botanical gardens, aquariums and zoos;
- arcades, amusement centres and parks as well as water parks;
- saunas and spas, except personal care provided therein;
- libraries other than those in educational institutions, except lending desks;
- movie theatres and rooms in which performing arts are presented, including venues where the arts are broadcast;
