

## IT IS SEXUAL ASSAULT TO SEXUALLY TOUCH ANY PART OF ANOTHER PERSON'S BODY WITHOUT THEIR CONSENT.

YOU CAN CONSENT WITH SOMEONE LESS THAN 5 YEARS OLDER THAN YOU.



YOU HAVE REACHED THE AGE OF CONSENT. THIS MEANS THAT YOU CAN GIVE CONSENT TO SEXUAL ACTIVITY EVEN IF THE OTHER PERSON IS MUCH OLDER THAN YOU.

UNDER AGE 18: IT'S <u>AGAINST THE LAW</u> FOR ANYONE IN A POSITION OF TRUST OR POWER OVER YOU TO HAVE SEXUAL CONTACT WITH YOU, EVEN IF YOU SAY YOU AGREE.

PEOPLE IN POSITIONS OF POWER OVER YOU ARE PEOPLE YOU WOULD NORMALLY DEPEND ON OR TRUST. SOME EXAMPLES ARE A TEACHER, COACH, FAMILY MEMBER, OR DOCTOR.
