The concert "Bonjour, Olá" offers classical music fans from the Drummondville region a unique opportunity to hear a varied and exciting repertoire on instruments not often brought together in the same program: classical guitar, the marimba and the vibraphone.

Dali Brillon is from a musical family and is pursuing musical studies in the "Virtuoso" profile at the Cégep de Drummondville. A versatile percussionist, he has developed a passion for the marimba and the vibraphone ever since being inspired at a concert of the Canadian percussionist, Marie-Josée Simard. He's looking forward to presenting an interesting program of music composed for the marimba and vibraphone, including pieces by David Friedman and Matthias Schmitt.

Daria Giritch and **Louis-Philippe Côté** began playing together as a classical guitar duo in a chamber music class given by guitarist and music instructor, Hughes Gagnon. The two musicians share a love of Latin and ethnic music from around the world. Daria began

playing piano and singing at 6 years old. She took up the guitar in elementary school, and although she focused her energy elsewhere during her high school years, she nevertheless continued to compose and arrange music, and decided to reconnect with the guitar by studying it seriously at Cegep. Louis-Philippe Côté's passion for classical guitar has kept growing since he first started to play at 8 years old. He has performed a wide-ranging repertoire, from baroque to contemporary to Latin music, in many performance contexts. Both students are currently completing their final year in the "Virtuoso" profile of the music department of the Cegep de Drummondville. Daria and Louis-Philippe will be joined by Jean-Philippe Bolduc for an arrangement for guitar trio of "Cordoba" by the Spanish composer, Isaac Albéniz.

The concert is presented by community organization CASE-MCQ and the St. George's Church Foundation as part of their partnership with les Productions Artscène. The goal of this concert series is twofold: to promote exciting, young and up-and-coming musicians enrolled in the music department of the Cégep de Drummondville, and to highlight the beauty and vitality of the historic St. George's Anglican Church. The organizers would like to thank their partners who have contributed to the success of these ongoing cultural events: the MRC of Drummond, Heritage Canada, and the Secrétariat aux relations avec les Québecois d'expression anglaise.

About the concert series

Launched last year as the "History and Music Concerts," the series is rebaptized this year as "St. George's Concerts and Special Events." Representing a dynamic partnership between St. George's Church Foundation and the English community organization CASE-MCQ together with les Productions Artscène, this new series will feature concerts showcasing local, young emerging talent, talks about fascinating aspects of local history, St. George's signature English tea social activities, and other unique events highlighting local heritage and culture. Events take place at the historic St. George's Church with its distinctive architecture, heritage stained-glass, and warm acoustics, or at the neighbouring St. George's Hall.
