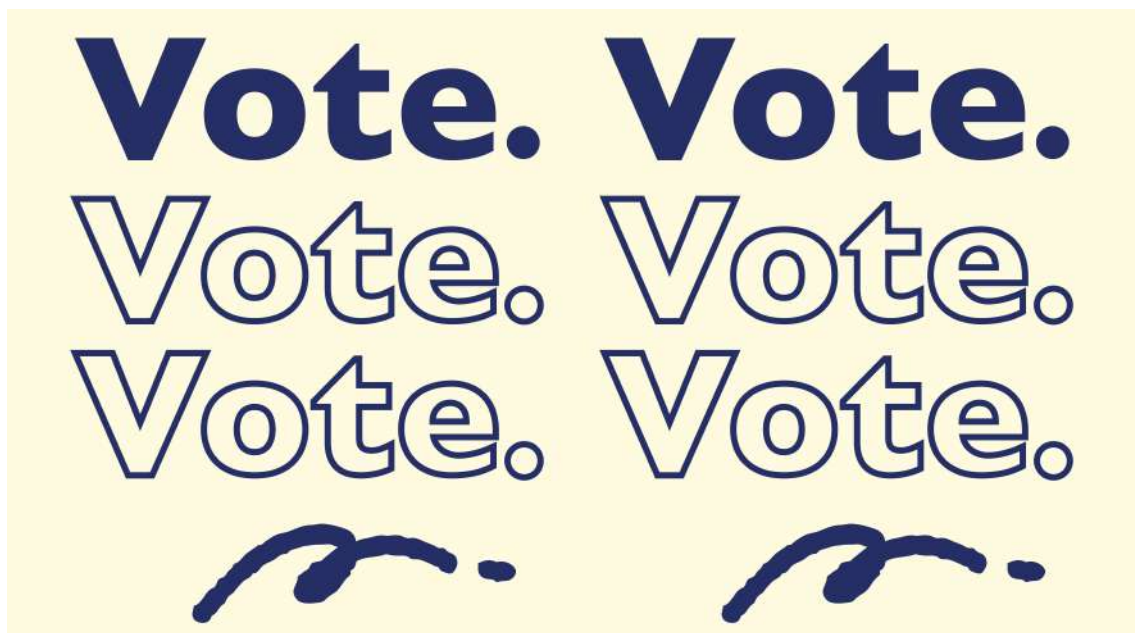

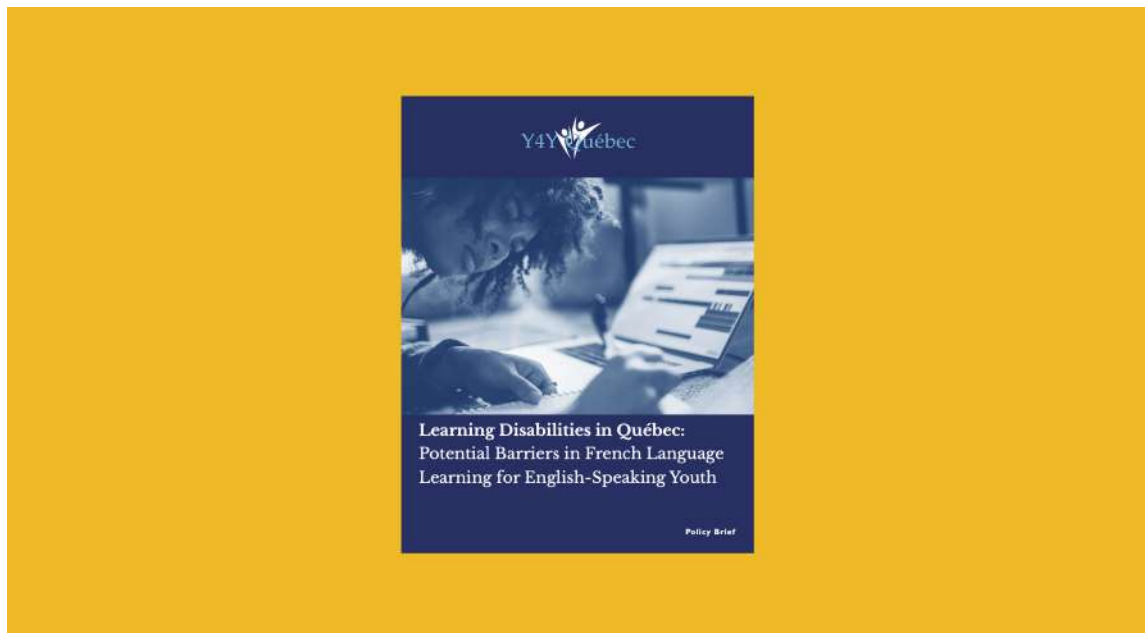

### Youth-led research: Latest publication

In Québec, students are often unaware they may have a learning disability until they reach a collegiate level where the work demanded is more intense than in high school. In 2010, it was found that 4.0% of college students from mother tongue English junior classes self-reported having a learning disability, such as dyslexia.
