Job Search Program

FOR YOUTH AGED 16 TO 35. This program includes daytime and evening workshops, individual career counselling, career testing services, paid internship programs, French courses, cover letter and résumé translation, a mentoring program, job postings, networking opportunities, a resource library, and free phone and computer access.

Entrepreneurship Program

OPEN TO ALL AGES. The entrepreneurship program offers daytime and evening workshops, one-on-one business coaching, a legal information clinic, as well as accounting clinics. YES has a comprehensive resource guide entitled: "The Montreal Entrepreneur's Guidebook", which is available for purchase at our centre. YES also hosts an annual entrepreneurship conference each spring, the largest English-language event of its kind in Quebec.

Artists' Program

OPEN TO ARTISTS OF ALL AGES AND DISCIPLINES. The YES Artists' Program offers workshops, employment counselling, business coaching, information and labs on artist grants.
