A large restoration project of the stained-glass windows of Drummondville's heritage St. George's Anglican Church is currently underway. Many of the windows were cracked or damaged, as well as having accumulated years of dirt and grime. Sylvie Savoie, an artist and Master Glass Painter whose workshop is in St-Lucien, is in charge of the restoration work, which is fastidious and delicate, requiring an eye for detail. She will give a presentation on what has been accomplished so far, as well as the techniques used for this specialized sort of restoration, techniques she perfected during an internship in France last year. The presentation will be in French, but a transcript of the talk will be available in English. It will be a unique opportunity to learn about the art of stained-glass, and to hear about the history of St. George's windows.

After the conference, the public is invited to the church hall for one of the St. George's Foundation's signature teas, including freshly baked scones with Devonshire cream and jam, tea, coffee, and other home-baked treats. Sylvie will do a hands-on demonstration during the tea and answer the public's questions about her work.
