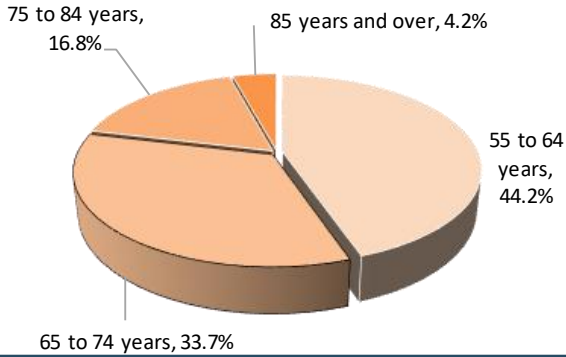

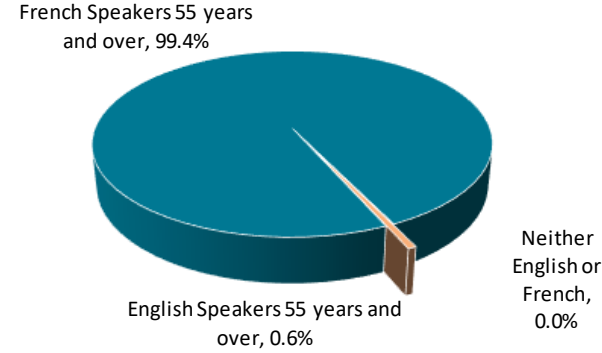

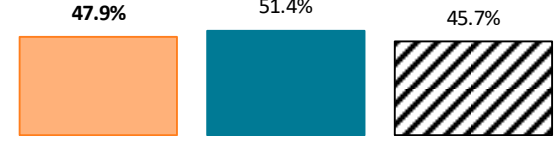
Proportion of English Speakers



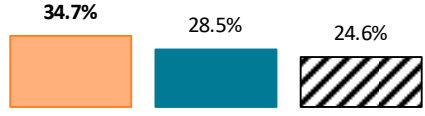
Lone Parent Family (55 years and over)



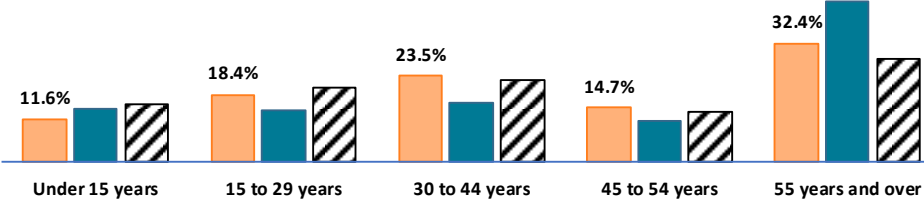
Low Education (55 years and over)



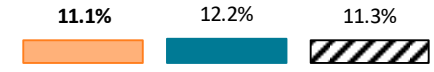
Living Alone (55 years and over)



Age Structure



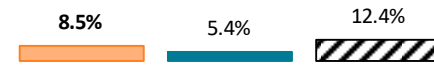
Unemployment (55 years and over)



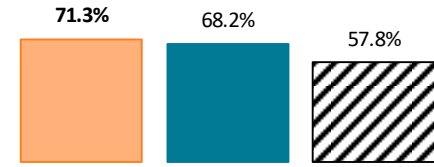
Recent Immigrants (55 years and over)



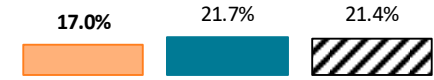
