

How to use the iPhone

- To turn on the iPhone press the power button on the right side of the iPhone
- To turn off the iPhone press the power button on the right side of the iPhone until you see the Slide to Power off button on the screen. This is to confirm that you really want to shut it off.
- To increase or decrease the volume of the iPhone press on the volume button on the left side of the iPhone.
- Press on the home button to return to the home screen of your iPhone.
- To download apps, go to the app store.




Texting and Calling


- To text look for the following icon  and click on it on your smart phone or tablet.

- When you are finished your message click on send.






How to make a phone call using Samsung Galaxy




How to use the iPad

- To turn on the iPad press the power button on the top right of the iPad
- To turn off the iPad press the power button on the top right of the iPad until you see the Slide to Power off button on the screen. This is to confirm that you really want to shut it off.
- To increase or decrease the volume of the iPad press on the volume button on the right side of the iPad.
- Press on the home button to return to the home screen of your iPad.
- To download apps, go to the app store.

Pros and Cons of devices

Pros

Laptops and Smart devices (smart phones and tablettes.)

- You can bring them anywhere.
- They are quick to use, efficient, and easily accessible.
- You can use them for many purposes for example (looking up directions, searching for recipes, searching for information about a trip you want to go on etc.).
- Cons: They can be a major distraction, time consuming, addictive, etc.

How to use the camera device on your smartphone or tablet




- When you take pictures they will automatically be stored in the photo library of your phone or tablet.
- The pictures will be stored in the order you took them, by location and time they were taken.

Working with and organizing photos (uploading and downloading photos)


- To transfer pictures from your device (smart phone, or tablet) to your computer, you need a USB cable. Connect your cable to your device and the other end to a computer.
- Create a file on your desktop by right clicking on your mouse, select first new, then folder. Give your new folder a name (example Summer 2019 or Jenny's wedding).
- Go to your pictures on your phone or tablet
- Authorize the transfer
- Check the pictures you want to transfer.   
- Click on import.
- When the transfer is done disconnect the cable.
- Create a new folder every time you transfer photos or add photos to an existing folder.

USB Cable



Online Safety Measures

- Password: don't use 123456, avoid your birthdate, your address, use different passwords for different logins (bank, credit cards, online orders, etc.) Change passwords regularly. Don't give your password to others, even family members or good friends.
- Log out: always log out when you are finished reading your email, checking your banking account, when you finish your session.
- Email: don't open a message from an unknown or an unreliable source and delete it.
- Never give any personal information on the internet (social security number, banking account numbers, passwords etc) .
- Photos from your trip: wait until you are back from your trip to post your pictures

What is Social Media?

- Social media are websites and applications that enable users to create and share content or to participate in social networking.
- Some forms of social media are Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, WhatsApp.

Which Social Media is good for you?

- Facebook: if you are trying to stay in communication with friends and family and if you want to meet new people.
- WhatsApp: to communicate with family and friends living far away (it's free).
- Twitter: if you want to follow famous people for example athletes, actors, musicians, artists and politicians.
- Instagram: if you want a simple, fun and creative way to capture, edit and share photos, videos and messages with friends.

Social Media: Facebook

- To create a Facebook account:
- Click on the web browser(Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox or Safari)
- In the Search Bar type Facebook.com
- Under the word sign up enter the following information (your first and last name, your mobile number or email, your password, your date of birth and your gender).
- When creating a password (use the criteria of slide 19 to create your password).
- At the very end of the registration process you will receive a code by email to confirm your registration. Enter this code immediately in your Facebook account, your Facebook account is now created.



Social Media: Twitter

- To create a Twitter account
- Click on the web browser(Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox or Safari)
- In the Search Bar type Twitter.com
- Click Create account and enter your name, your phone number or email address and your date of birth.
- Click on ``next`` where it says next and then click sign up.
- You will receive a code by email to confirm your registration. Enter this code immediately in your Twitter account, your Twitter account is now created.
- The last step is to create a password (use the criteria of slide 19 to create your password).







Social Media: WhatsApp

- To install WhatsApp on your smartphone
- Click on the Appstore icon
- In the search bar type WhatsApp
- The icon you are looking for is this one
- Once you have found it click on it and download it, and then click on open.
- Follow the steps to upload your contacts to WhatsApp.
- You can text, talk on the phone or video chat for free (Wifi required).



Search Engines

Using Google's Search Engine



- To utilize Google's Search Engine, simply type whatever it is you would like to research or find in the search box
 - Then click the Google Search Button.

Choosing a strong password

How to create a strong password (Trick)

1) Think of a phrase or sentence with at least eight words. It should be something easy for you to remember but hard for someone who knows you to guess. It could be a line from a favorite poem, story, movie, song lyric, or quotation you like. Example: **"I Want To Put A Dent In The Universe"**

2) Remove all but the first letter of each word in your phrase: **IWTPADITU**

3) Replace several of the upper-case letters with lower case ones, at random: **iWtpADitU.**

4) Now substitute a number for at least one of the letters. (Here, we've changed the capital "I" to the numeral 1): **iWtpAD1tU**

5) Finally, use special characters (\$, &, +, !, @) to replace a letter or two -- preferably a letter that is repeated in the phrase. You can also add an extra character to the mix. (Here, we've replaced the "t" with "+", and added an exclamation point at the end.) : **iW+pAD1tU!**

- In the search bar type Hotmail or Gmail.
- On either of these sites click on create account.
- To create your account type the name of your choice in the box. example: johnsmith or smithjohn or john.smith, jothec clown, etc.
- Your email address will be for example jothec clown@hotmail.com, johnsmith@gmail.com, then create your own password (avoid obvious choices). Now choose a password.
- Now give your email address to all your contacts.

How to create a Gmail Account





How to retrieve and send your messages

- Open your browser (Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari).
- Type Gmail or Hotmail in the search bar depending on your address.
- Click on the login icon.
- Type your email address in the box and your chosen password
(8 characters minimum, letters and numbers and at least one special character. See next page for choosing a strong password).
- You will have access to your messages. Click on one to read it. To answer, click reply. To delete a message, click on the garbage can icon. To log out, click on sign out. To send a message, click on **new message**, enter the email address of your contact, write your message and press **send** at the end.

How to Send an email with Gmail



Online Banking

Click on the web browser (Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox or Safari)

In the search bar type the name of your banking institution. Enter your banking card number and choose a password(make sure not to choose an obvious one)

Click on register

You will see your accounts information right away.

You will be able to send money, pay bills, transfer money between accounts.

To make things easier you can download the application of your banking institution on your screen.

Don't forget to click on quit at the end of your session.



On YouTube you can watch videos and listen to music.

Type YouTube.com in your internet browser (Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, Safari, Mozilla Firefox etc.)

To have a YouTube account you must create a Google account and follow the instructions.


Click on sign in and this will bring you to the Google page to create your Google account.

You don't need a Youtube account to use YouTube.

Online Games

To download games on your computer, smart phone or tablet click on the app store icon.
