Commitment to Strategic Priorities Contained Within the 2012 – 2017 Community Priorities and Enabling Strategies of the English-speaking Community of Quebec

(Proposed Resolution of the Members)

Recalling the Strategic Priorities Forum conducted in 2011 and 2012 that included 19 regional and sectoral consultations, five focus groups, an online survey of more than 500 English-speaking Quebecers, and two-day conference of community leaders, all of which sought the community's input on the priorities for a vital and sustainable English-speaking community;

Noting the six strategic priorities identified by the Strategic Priorities Forum: access to services in English; community building; economic prosperity; identify and renewal; leadership and representation; and, strong institutions;

Recognizing the QCGN as the English-speaking Community of Quebec's strategic representative organization and leader in the community's development priorities identification process;

Taking note of the Government of Canada's objective of adopting a new Action Plan for Official Languages beginning in 2018;

- 1. Recommits to the six strategic priorities identified by the Strategic Priorities Forum, with a view to revisiting them following the adoption of the Government of Canada's Action Plan for Official Languages; and,
- 2. Directs that an evaluation be conducted related to the community priority-setting process prior to the next Annual General Meeting, and empowers the QCGN Board to act on the evaluation's recommendations.
