### 'At a Distance' Art Show Brings People Together

You know people are craving a social event when the concept of fashionably late is completely disregarded. A special 4Korners vernissage recently took place at the Activity Center in Deux-Montagnes to highlight some amazing creations done during the pandemic. The evening was broken into two viewings in order to respect COVID protocols while still offering a convivial environment of art viewing and mingling. The two showings began at 5:00 pm and 7:00 pm respectively. At 5:00 pm on the nose there was a steady stream of the maximum number of confirmed guests, and it was the same situation at the 7:00 pm showing. People came, took in the amazing art display put together by a passionate 4Korners staff, and enjoyed some bubbly and light snacks offered in the special "dining" section.

The testimonials placed under the paintings were enough to bring a tear to the eye, but having artists and community members alike be moved emotionally when speaking to me about the classes and the first in-person social event in over a year was extremely validating. Artist Rebecca Fillion took part via Zoom, watching through the eyes of the 4Korners owl camera, part of the tech investment made during the pandemic to help remote joiners feel more a part of in-person events. Rebecca's testimonial under her drawing of a bird emerging from the flame of a candle shared how the class supported the full-time caregiver through her brother's final days in his battle with cancer.

Ellie Downing was surprised to have four pieces displayed, the seascapes her personal favorite. The subject matter was deliberately selected to transport the

passion that she didn't know she had. And then there was Ben, a 19-year-old with autism, who took part in the seniors' drawing group and had multiple pieces on display, from line drawings to clay sculptures. He moved about the room dodging my recorder but proudly showed me his favourite drawings and struck a pose in front of his pieces for his mom's photo collection. His mom, Julie, told me she doesn't know how they would have made it through the pandemic without these classes. She said Ben grew so much as an artist learning from the star of the night, art teacher Carol Lyng. #### THEMES TO BE EXPLORED:

- Understanding anger and violence in self.
- · Body and emotions: underneath anger and fear... shame, powerlessness.
- · Understanding anger in relationships: patterns and attitudes.
- Triggers: differentiating truths that are difficult to hear or deal with. Dealing with wounds from the past and the sensitive spots they leave behind.
- Self-talk and the ways we shape our understanding: building up either anger or compassion.
- · Game playing: blaming, guessing, mind reading.
- Couple: conflict resolution.
- · Impacts of drinking problems and substance abuse.

Small online groups consisting of 4-5 men. Weekly 1hr evening meetings, complimented by "personal work" (videos, documents, exercises).
