Nakuset, the Executive Director of the Native Women's Shelter of Montréal, is Cree from Lac la Ronge, Saskatchewan. She has three beautiful boys, Kistin, Mahkisis and Mahihkan. Nakuset was adopted by a Jewish family in Montréal and draws on her adoptee experience for insight on her work advocating for the Aboriginal children in care. She is the copresident of the Montréal Urban Aboriginal Community Strategy Network. Her most recent accomplishments include creating, producing and hosting the television series "Indigenous Power", as well as being voted "Woman of the Year" by the Montreal Council of Women. Nakuset is dedicated to improving the lives of urban aboriginals.
