

Canada Post Fires Whistle-Blower

Montreal, Monday, February 25, 2002-Alliance Quebec President Brent Tyler will be holding a press conference tomorrow with Alan Greer, the postal worker who has been leading the fight to get Canada Post to comply with the Official Languages Act. Mr. Greer was fired last Friday. Canada Post management had subjected Mr. Greer to constant harassment since he complained to the Office of the Commissioner of Official Languages about violations of the Official Languages Act by Canada Post. Mr. Greer was vindicated by the investigation by the Office of the Commissioner of Official Languages that found that his complaints were well founded and that Canada Post was not complying with the Official Languages Act. The Office of the Commissioner of Official Languages was carrying out an investigation of the harassment of Mr. Greer and other whistle-blowers at Canada Post when Mr. Greer was fired.
