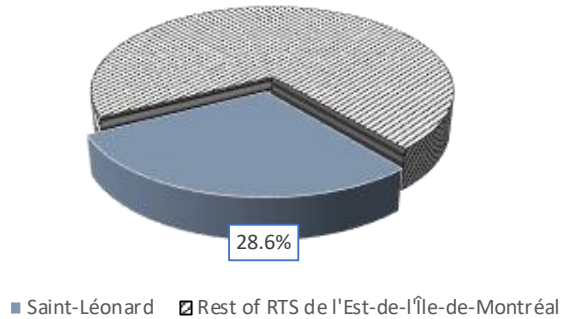

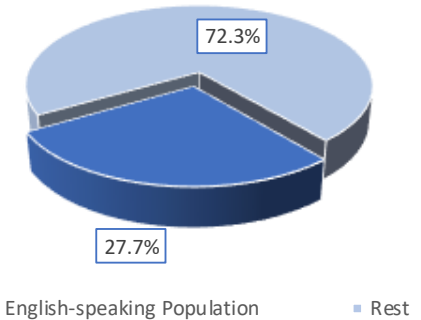
Share of English-speaking Population



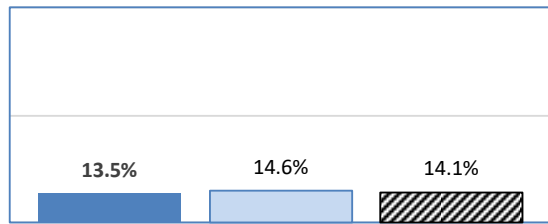

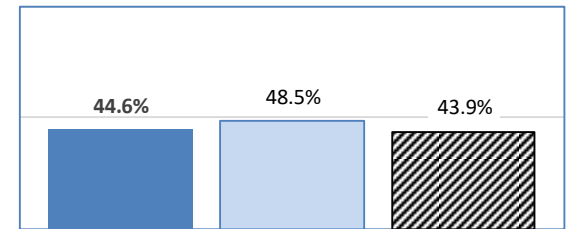

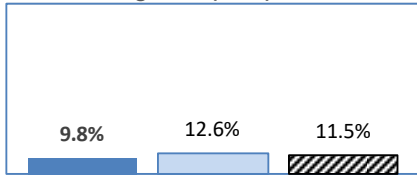
Lone Parent Family (Total)



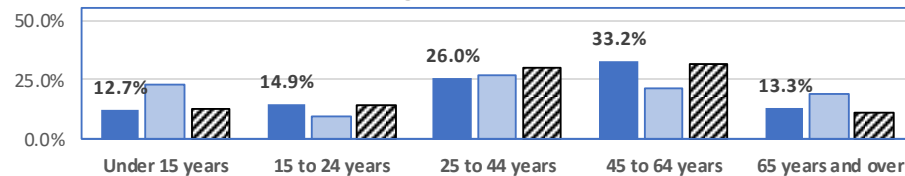

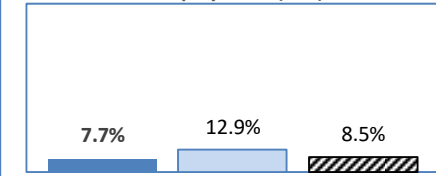

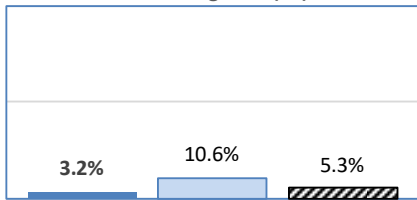
Age Structure



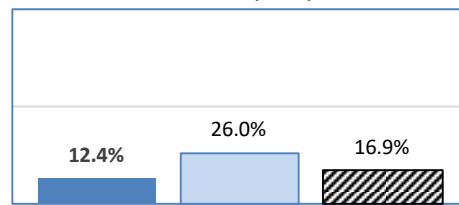

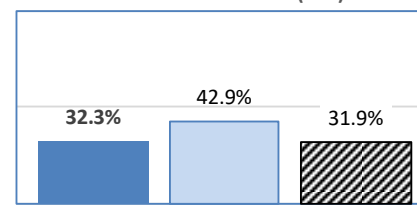

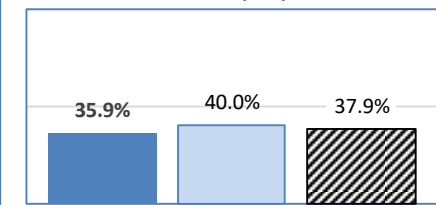

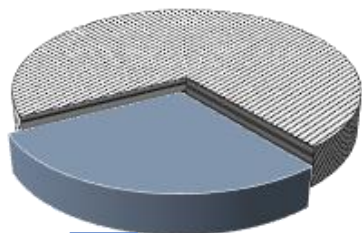

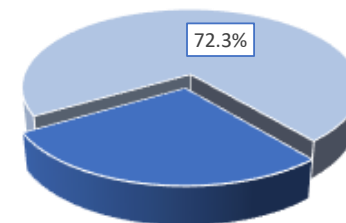

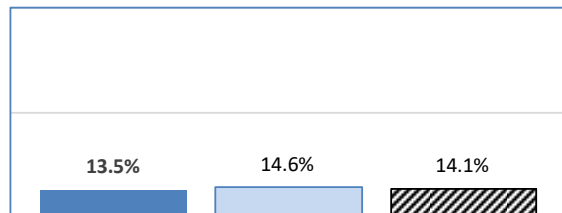

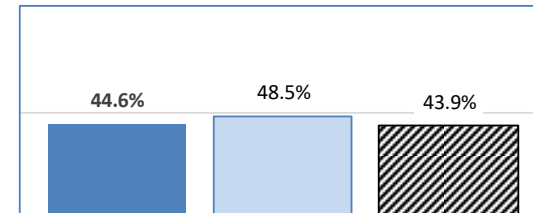

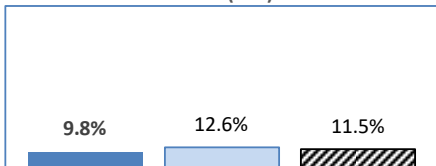
Familles monoparentales (totale)



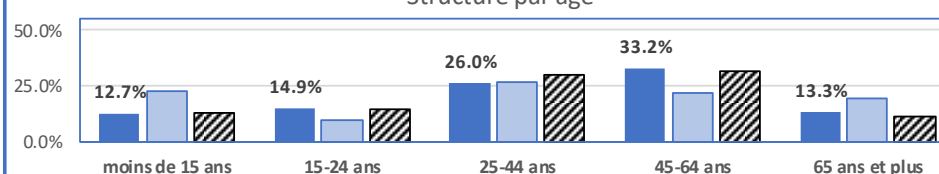

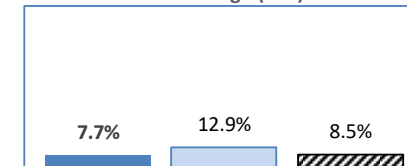

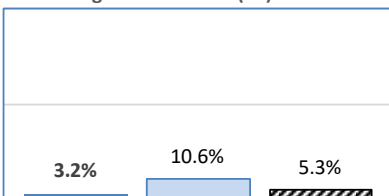
Structure par âge



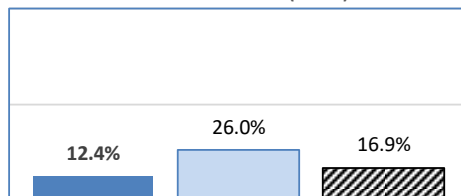
Taux de chômage (15+)



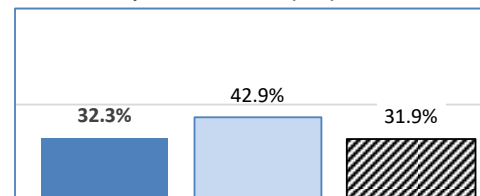

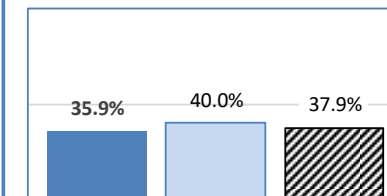
