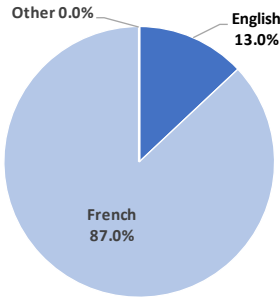


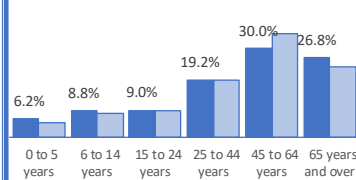

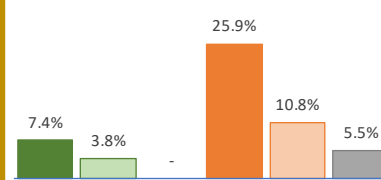

Population by Age Group

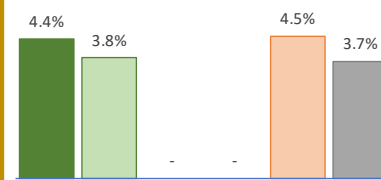

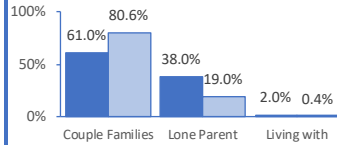
Parents Aged 15 to 24 Years



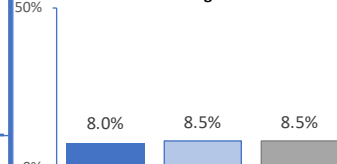

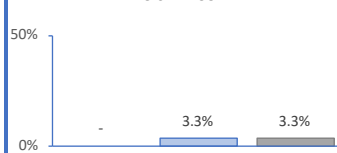
Household Living Arrangements of Children 0 to 5



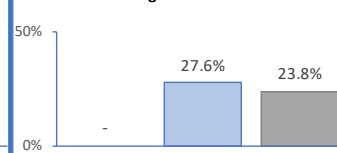

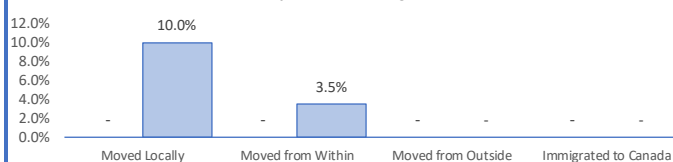
Children 0 to 5 in Couple Families Living Below LICO

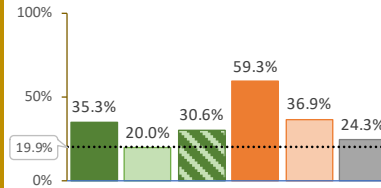


Recent Mobility (1 Year) Among Children 0 to 5

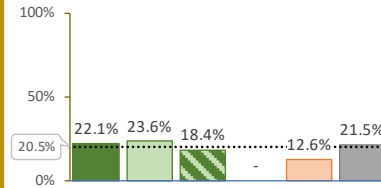

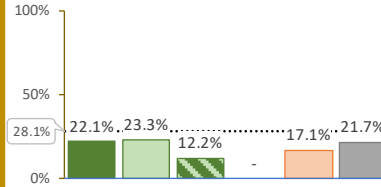

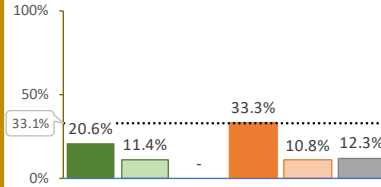

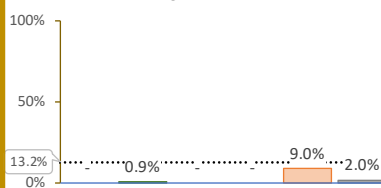

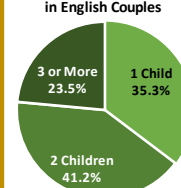

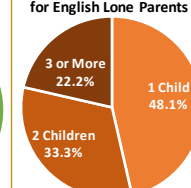

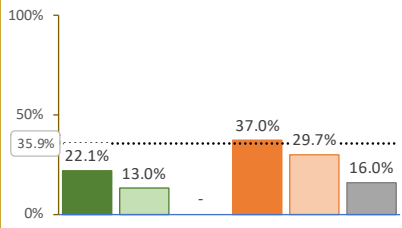
Number of Children 0 to 5 in English Couples



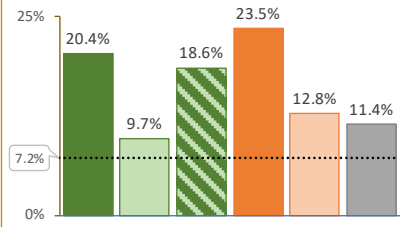
Number of Children 0 to 5 for English Lone Parents

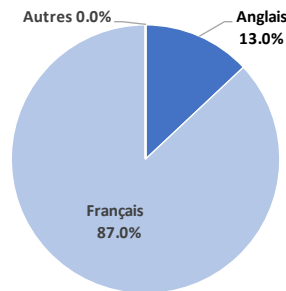

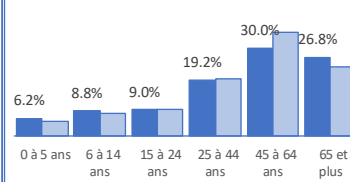

Enfants de 0 à 5 ans par Première Langue Officielle Parlée



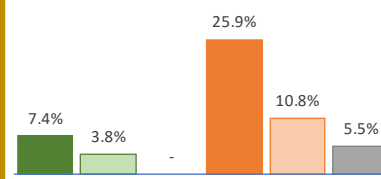

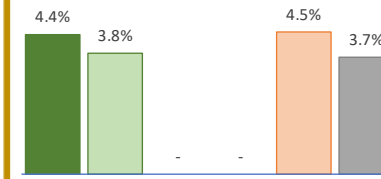

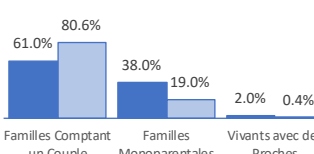

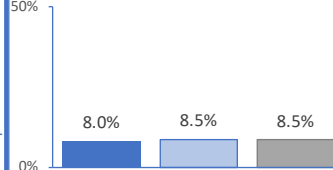

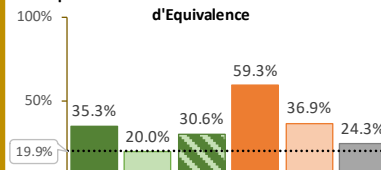
Situation des Particuliers dans le Ménage des Enfants de 0 à 5 ans



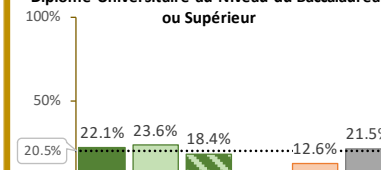

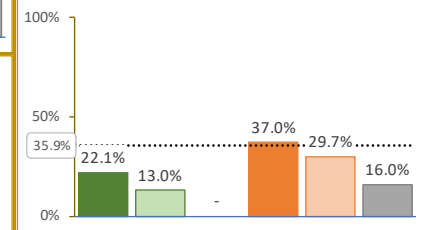

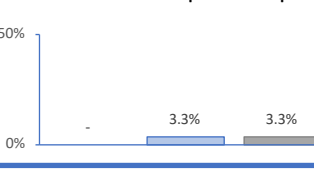

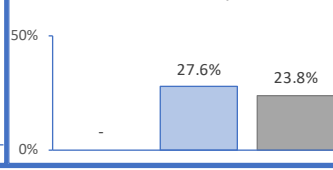

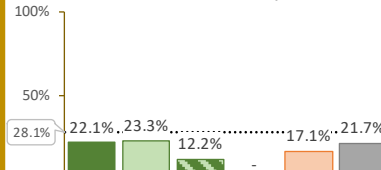

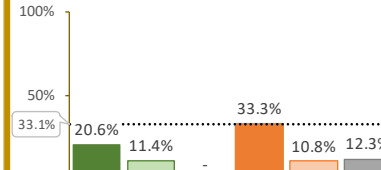

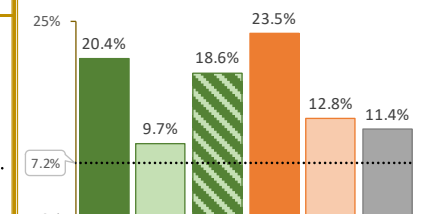

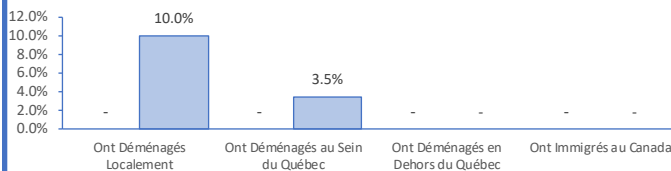

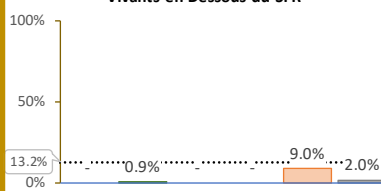

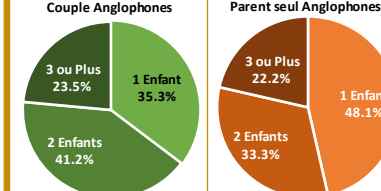

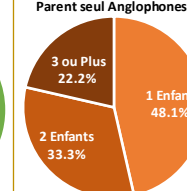
