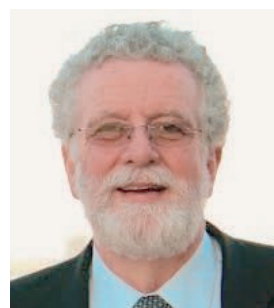
QFHSA AWARD RECIPIENTS
