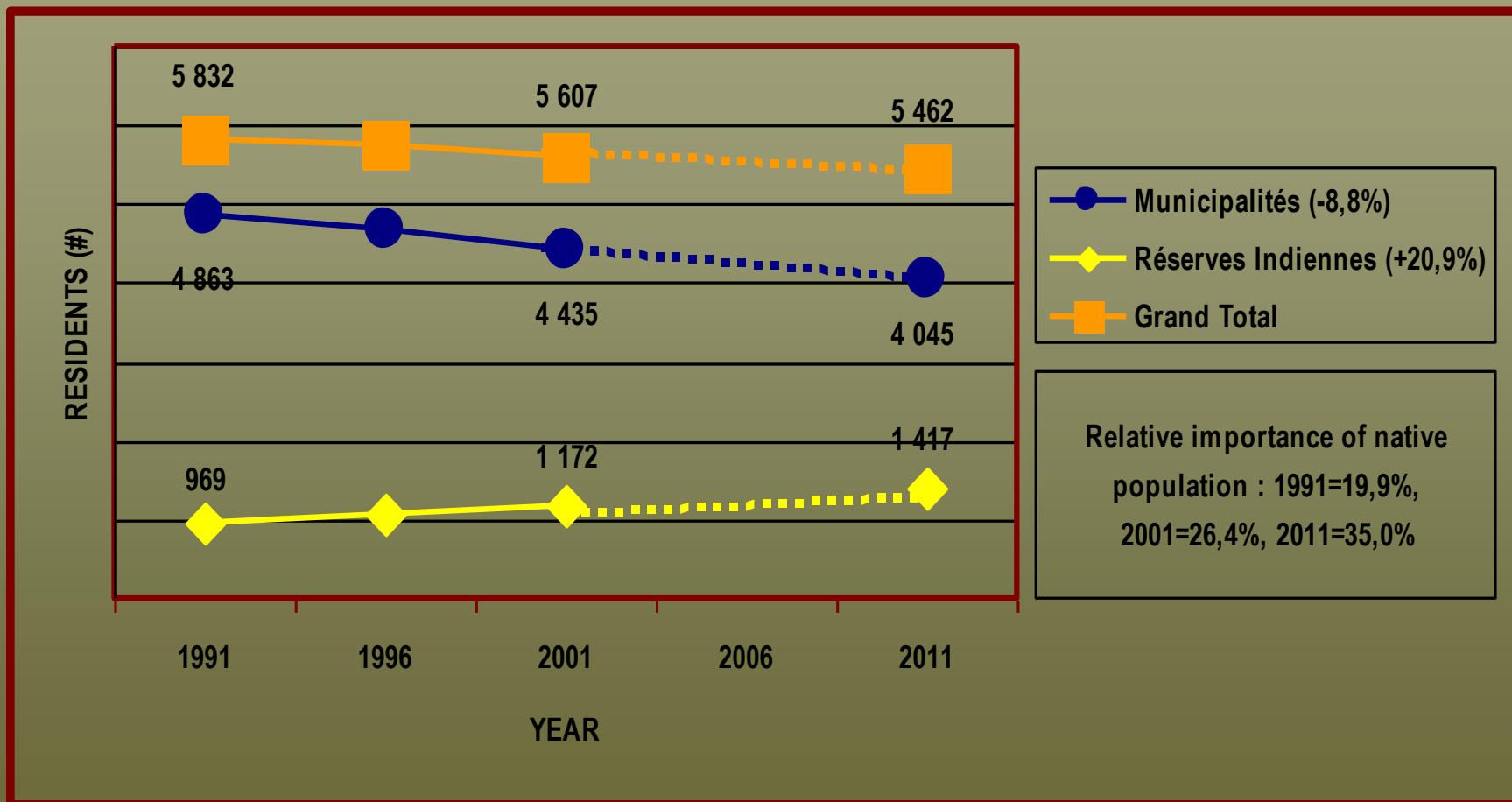

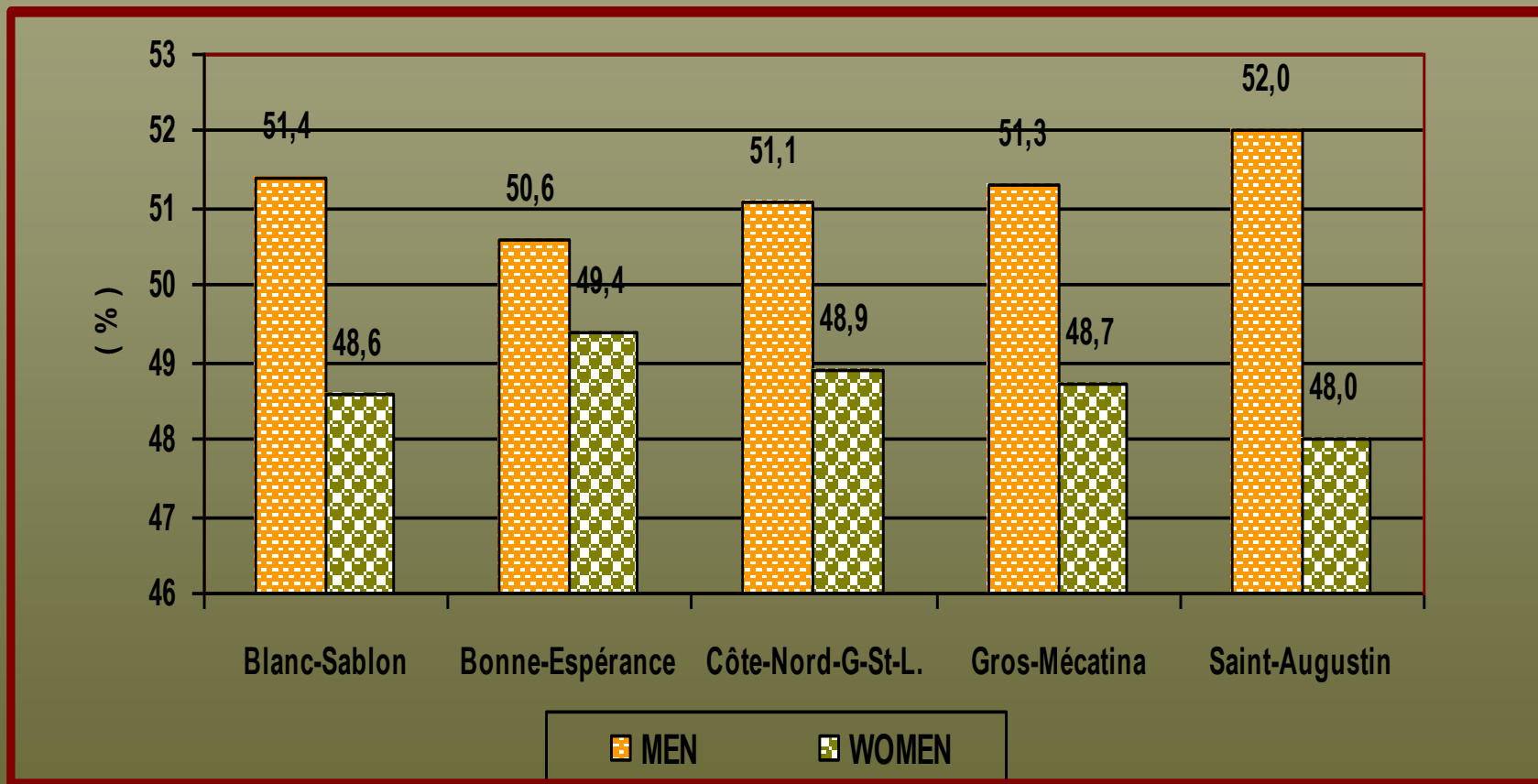

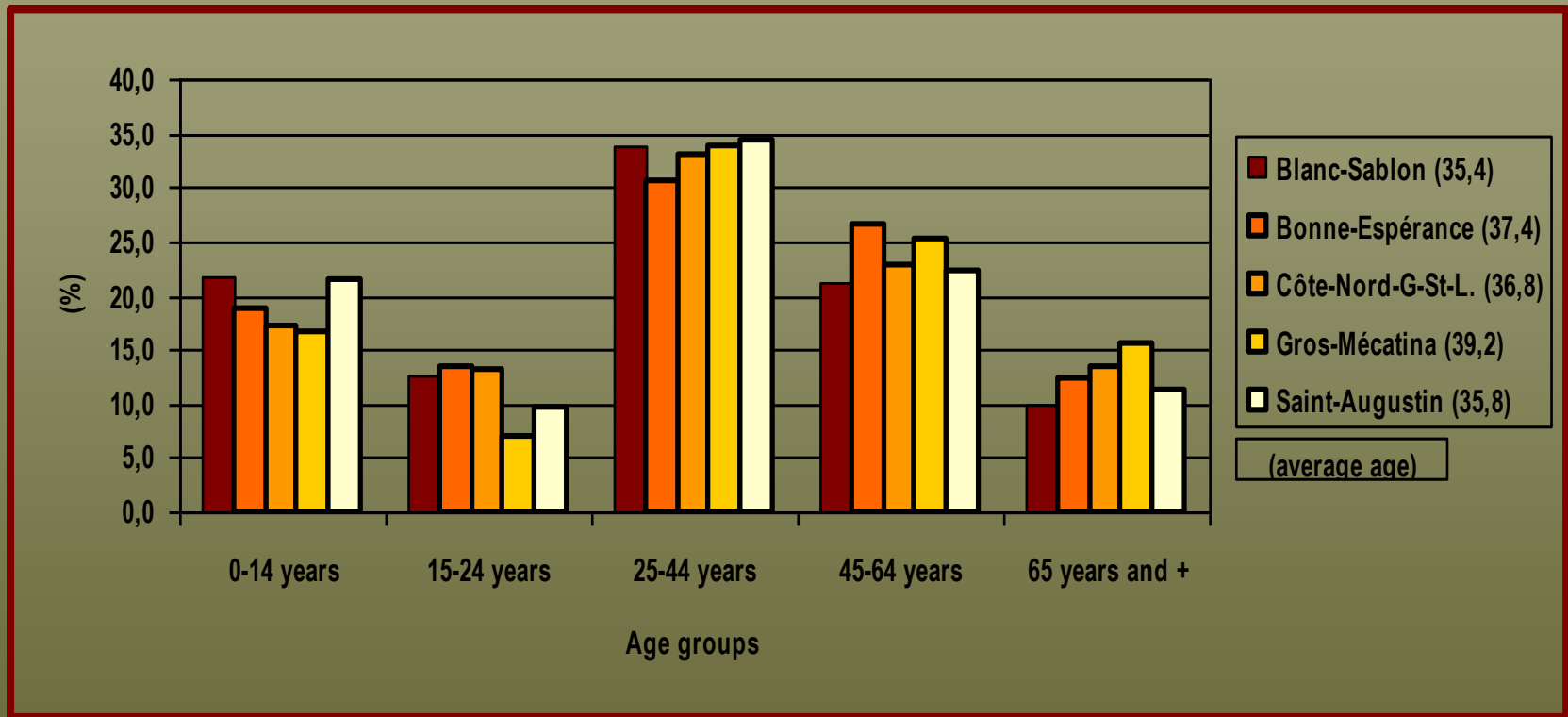
Population for 1991-2001 and linear projection for 2011



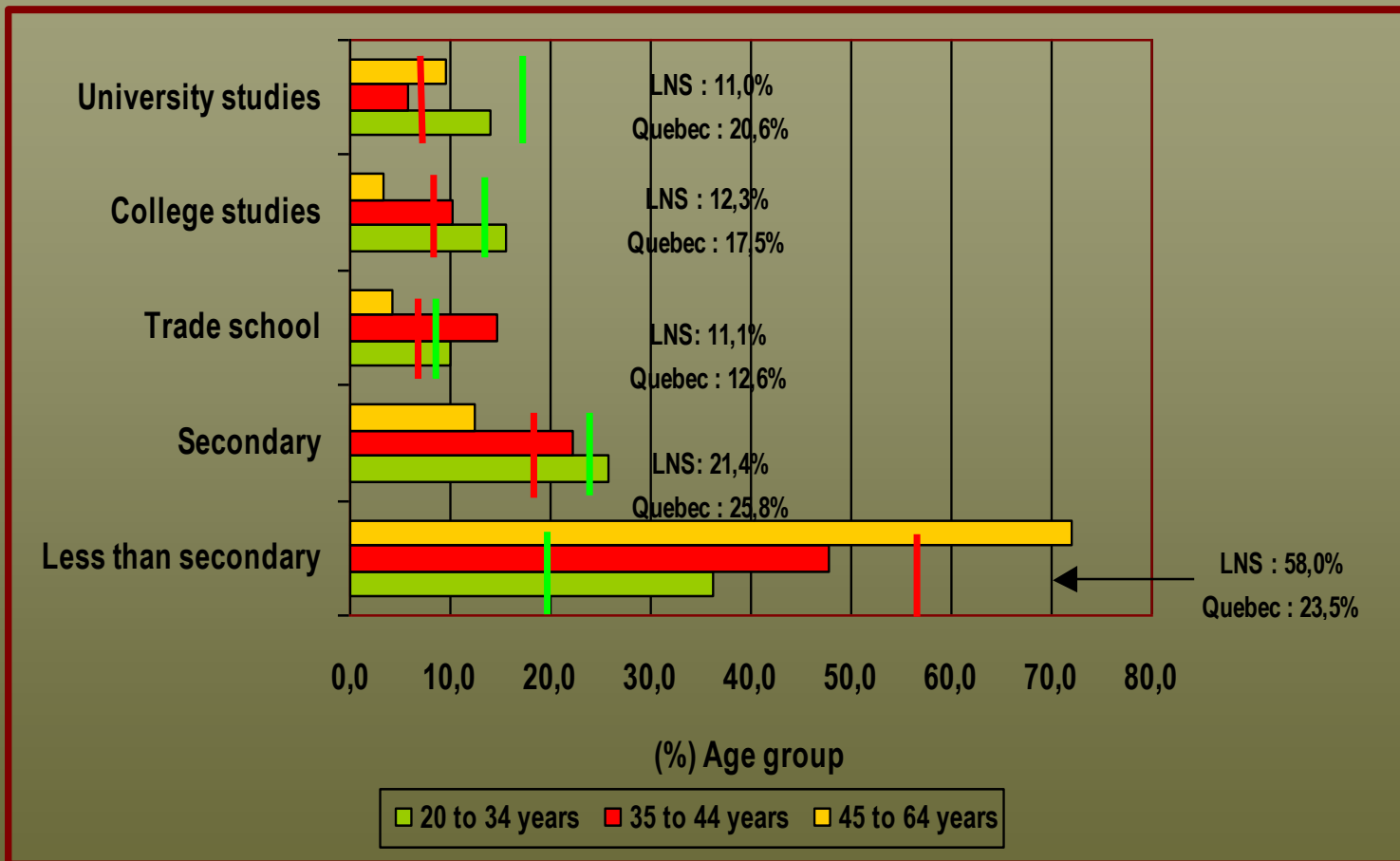
Municipal populations according to sex (2001)



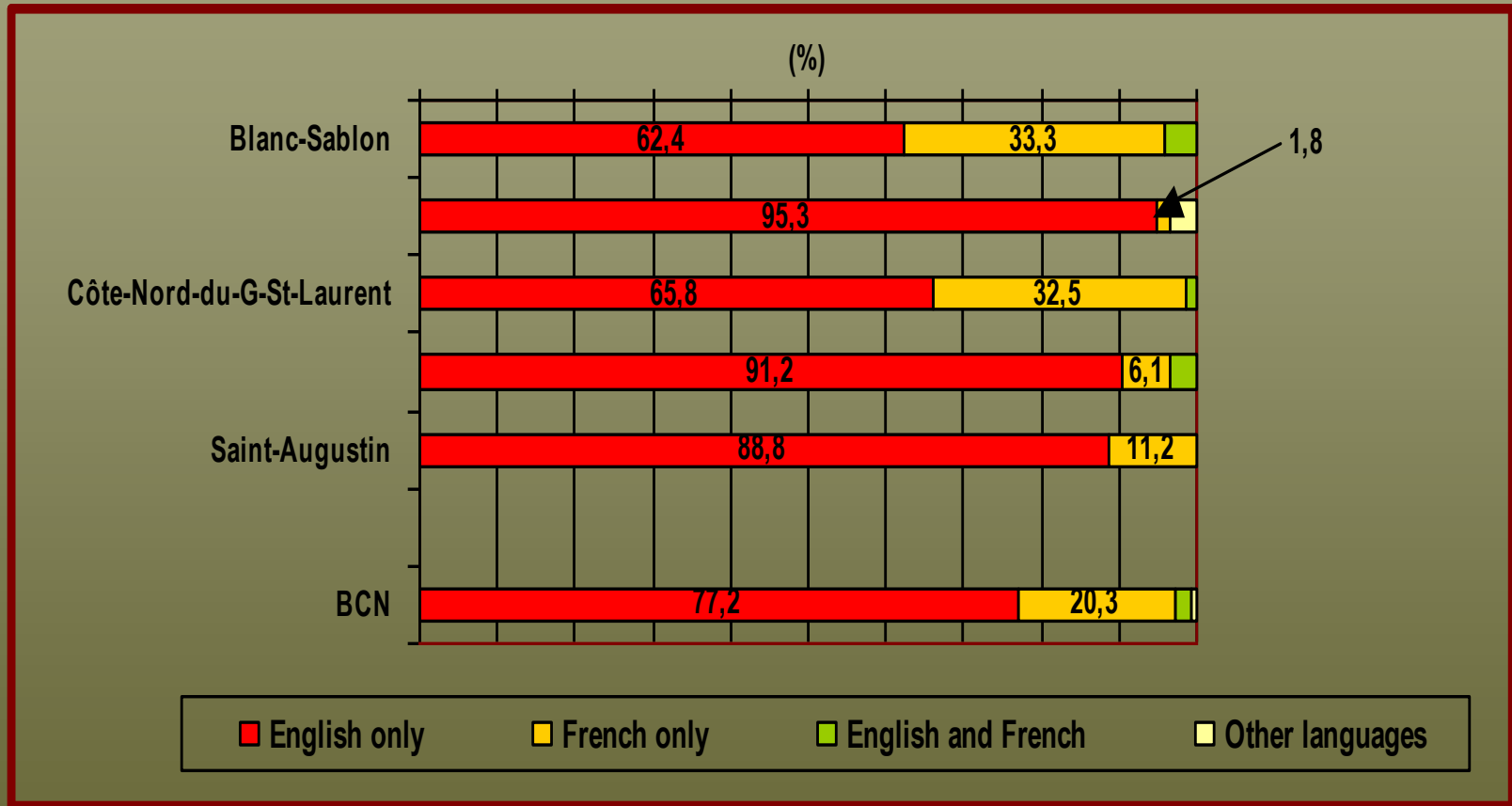
Municipal populations according to age groups (2001)



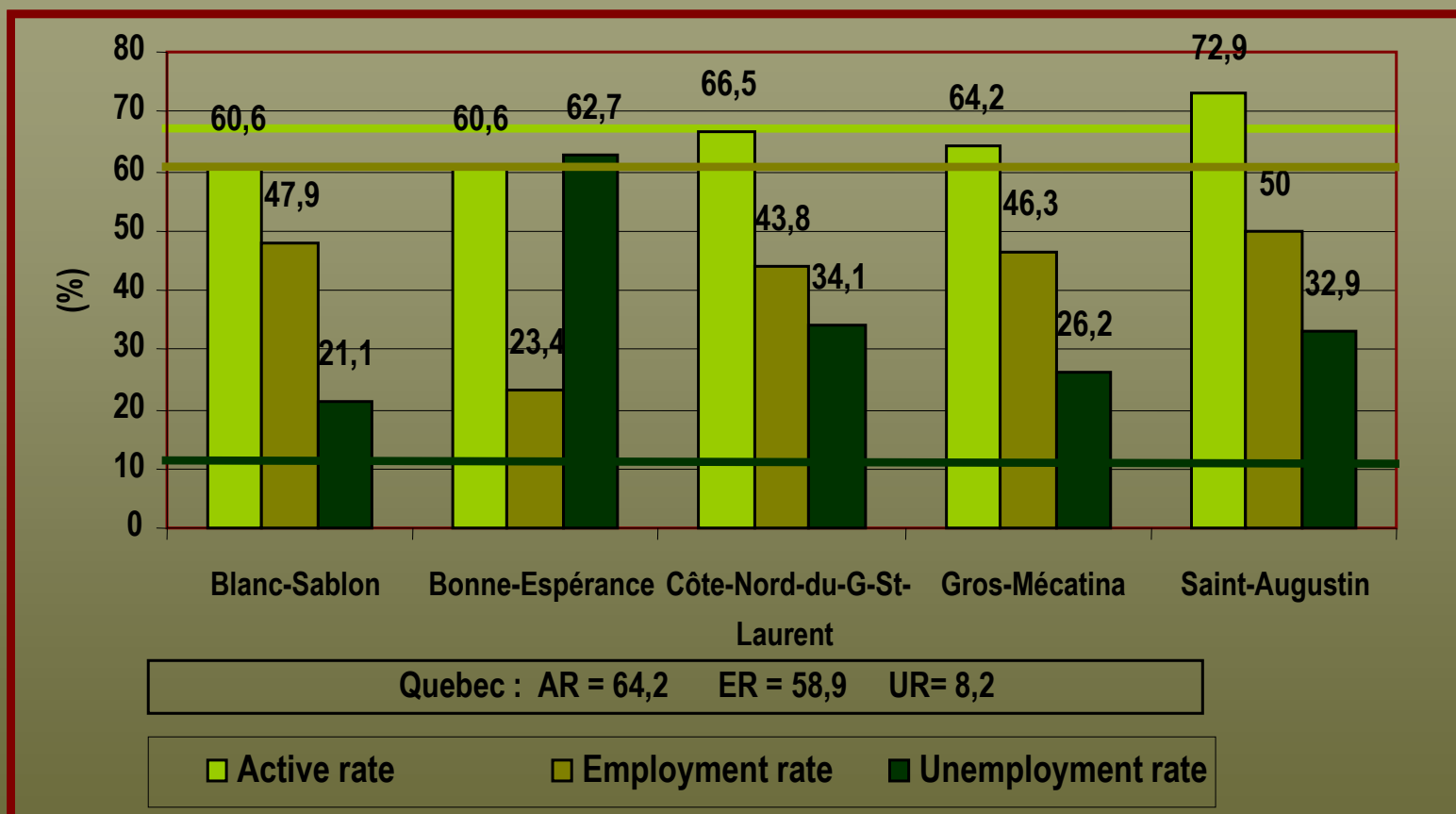
Education according to age groups (2001)



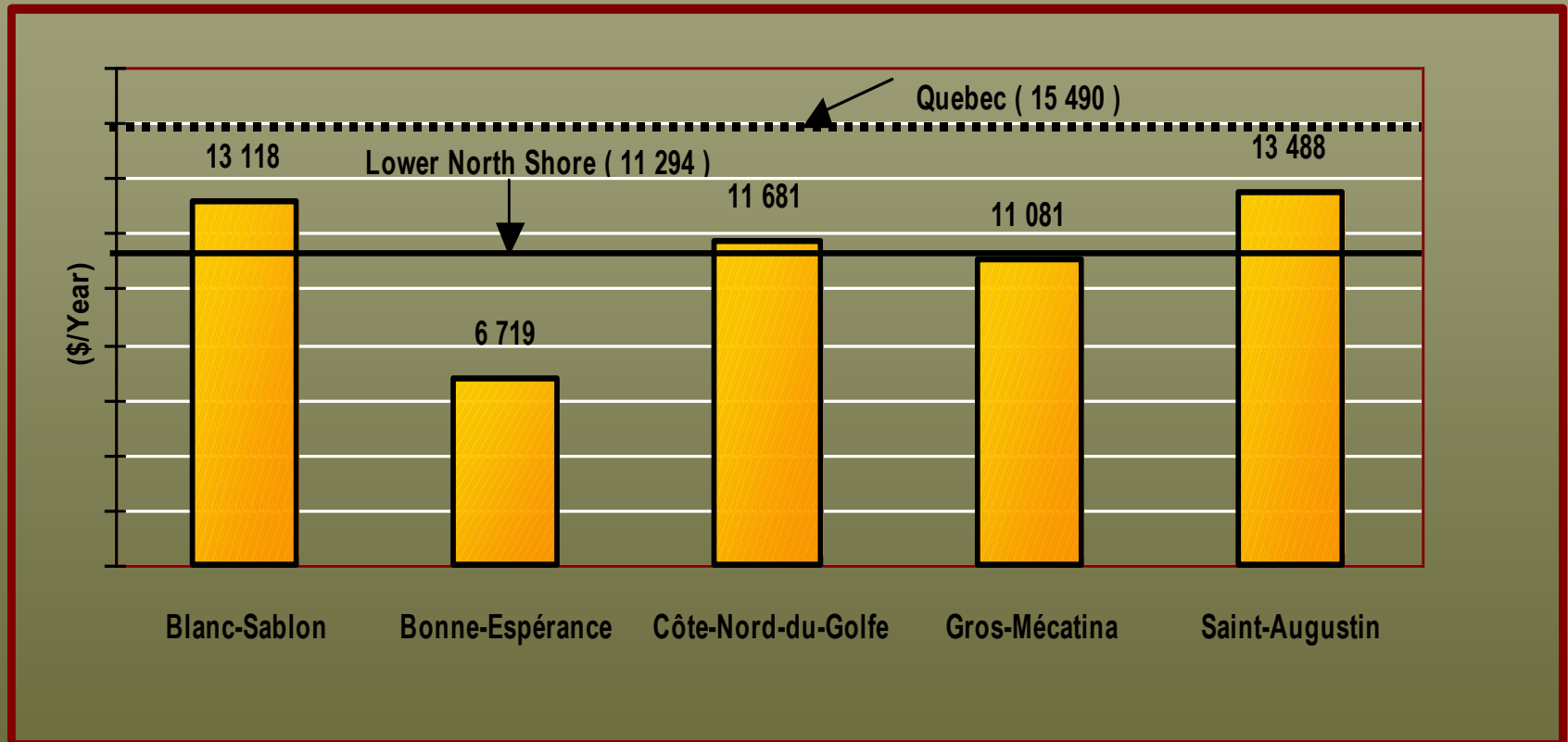
First language spoken and still understood (2001)



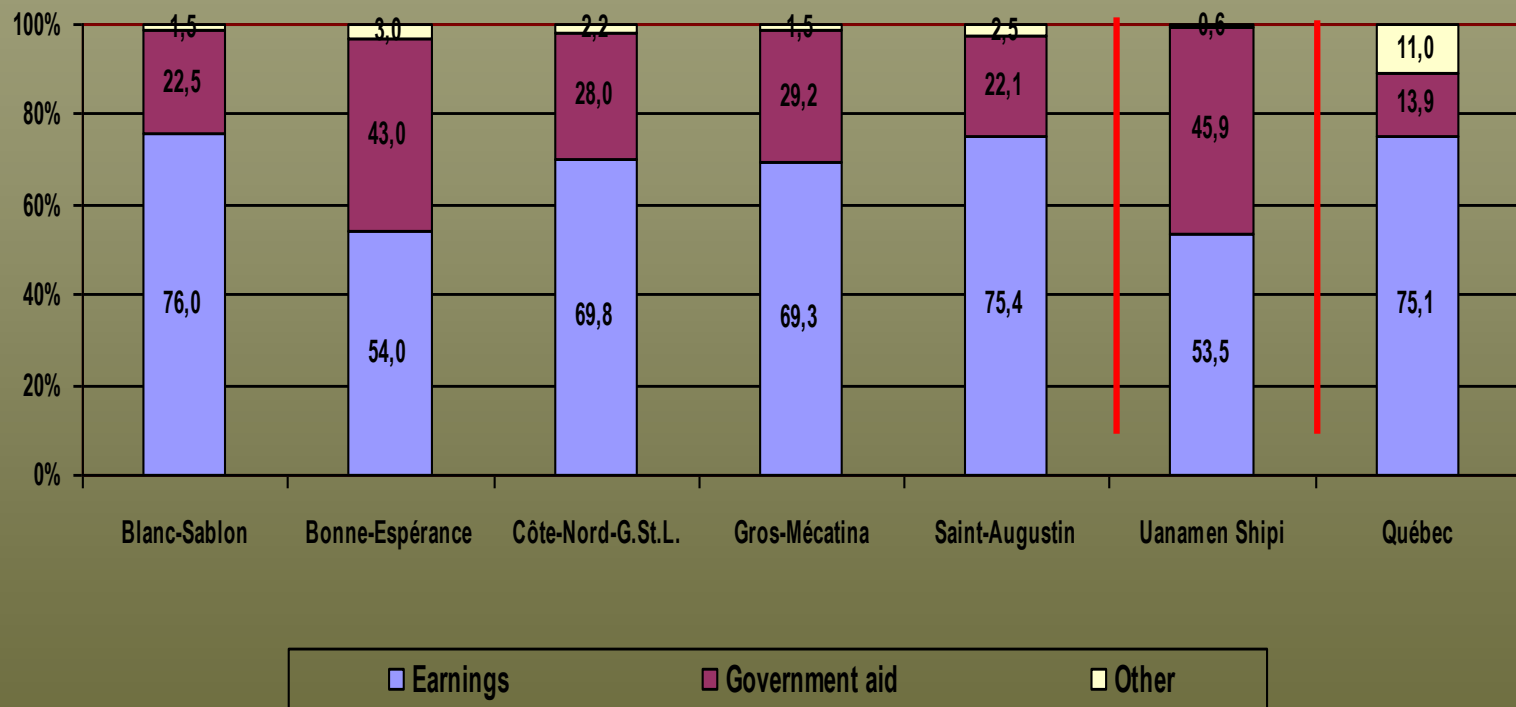
Indicators of the labor force (2001)
