2021 Flu Vaccination

This year the influenza vaccine for the seasonal flu is being offered in our region, however, it may be organized differently due to the ongoing pandemic. You will need an appointment to get the flu vaccine again this year.

If you live in a residence or are in the hospital or are followed regularly by your CLSC:

- please check with the health team around you as they will be organizing appointments to distribute the vaccine. As of Monday October 18, in the territory of Chaudière Appalaches:
 - you are able to book an appointment online at **www.monvaccin.ca**; OR
 - call 1-855-480-8094, Monday-Friday 08:00-12:00 and 1:00-4:00 pm

The flu vaccine is free for the following people:

- People with a chronic illness, for example, diabetes, problems with the immune system, lung or heart problems, kidney disease, dementia, obesity, cancer, etc.
- 75 years old or older; healthy children 6-23 months old; healthy people from 60-74 yrs.
- Pregnant women in the 2nd or 3rd trimester
- People who are at risk of transmitting the virus to a susceptible person who is at high risk of complications: for example, if you are living under the same roof, if you are a caregiver, and /or living with an infant less than 6 months old.
- A health care worker working with people who are at high risk of complications.

If you are not among those eligible for the free vaccination:

• You can also get the vaccine in your preferred vaccine clinic (CLSC, medical clinic or pharmacy). Prices may vary.
