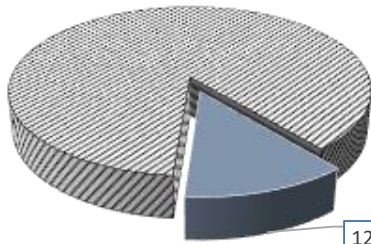

Share of English-speaking Population

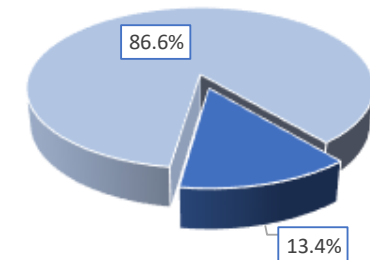

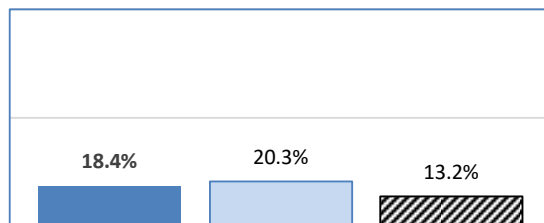

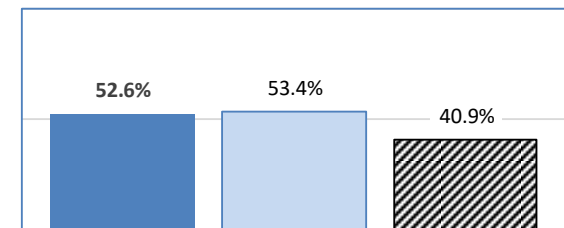

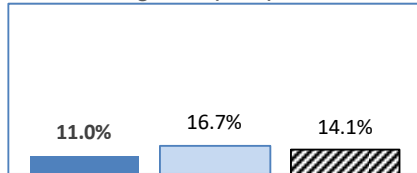
Lone Parent Family (Total)



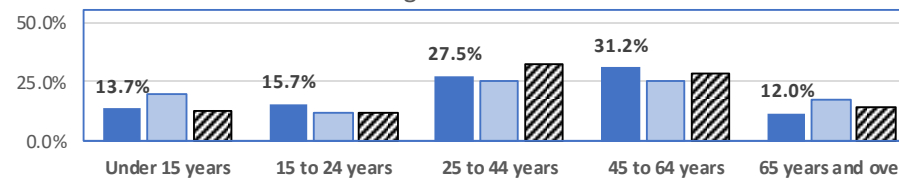
Low Education (15+)



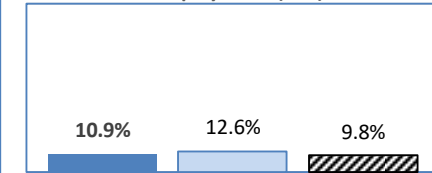
Living Alone (Total)



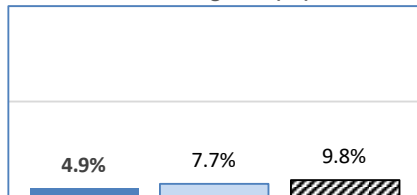
Age Structure



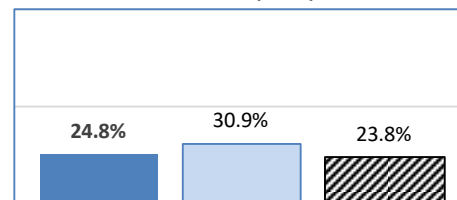

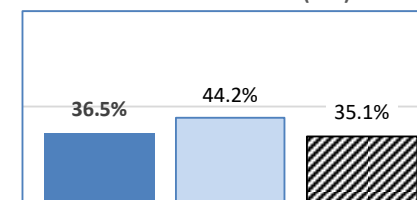

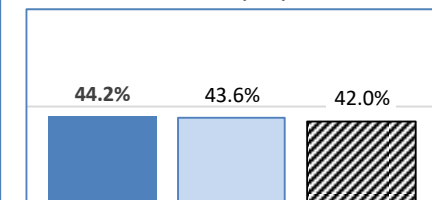

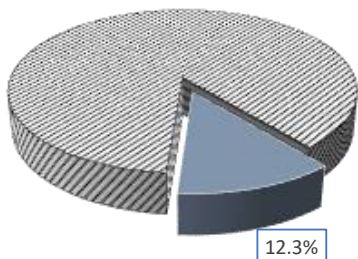

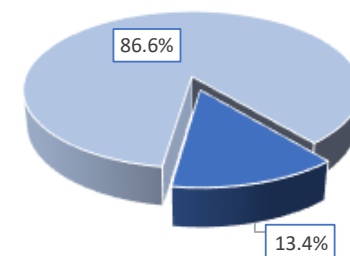

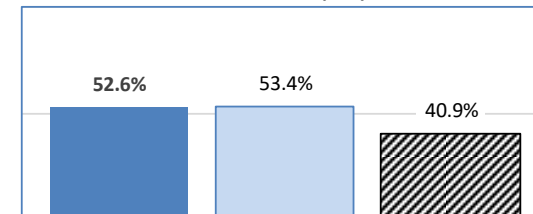

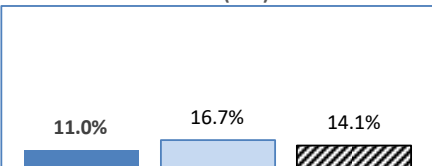
Familles monoparentales (totale)



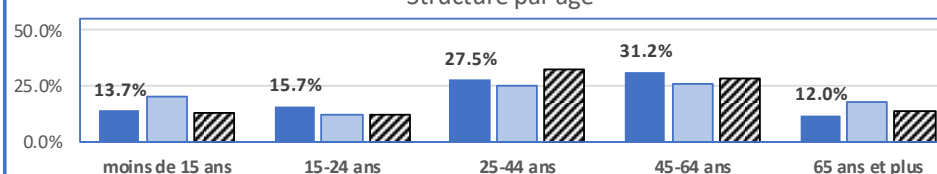

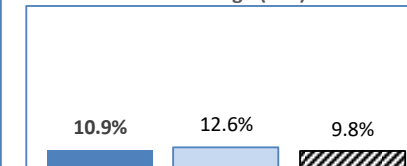

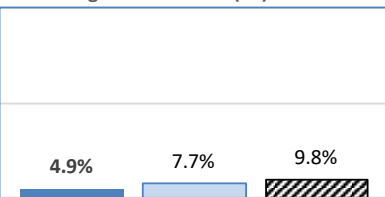
Structure par âge



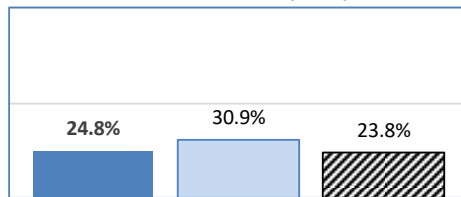

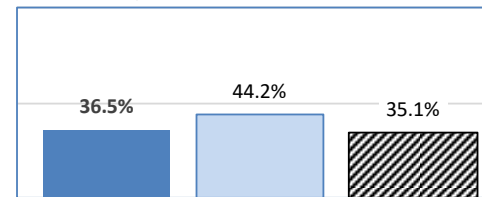

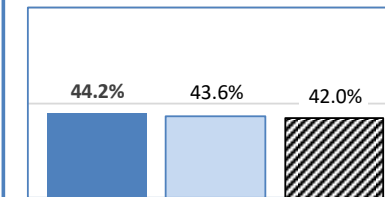
