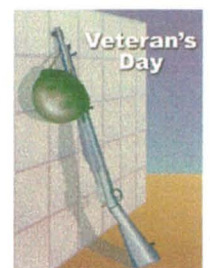
Track and Field

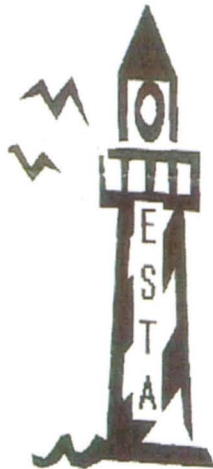

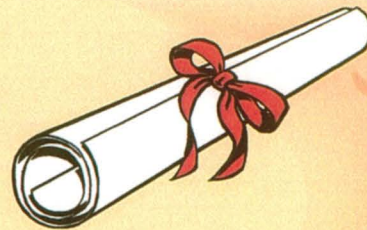
