Y4Y Québec and ECO-02 invite youth to attend a bilingual panel discussion on locals' opinion of Law 96.

Saguenay, Thursday 22 September 2022 : On Thursday, October 13 from 6 to 8 p.m., Y4Y Québec and ECO-02 are hosting a discussion at Le Montagnais Hotel in Chicoutimi, where panelists will share their thoughts on Bill 96. This public conversation will highlight English- and French-speaking panelists from the region who will discuss their vision of the law, its positive aspects, its shortcomings, as well as its impact on the future of the communities it targets. They will express how they feel about the law and the changes they would make to it. This discussion will take place in a context of understanding and respect, so as to gain a better understanding of everyone's reality.

The activity is aimed primarily at young people aged 16 to 35, but the general public and the media are welcome and are encouraged to attend. This discussion is intended to be apolitical and non-partisan. Translators will be present and the event will end with a question and answer period.
