

## McGill Health & Social Services Bursary Program 2022-2023 CALL FOR APPLICANTS

McGill University, with the collaboration of MCDC, is pleased to launch the call for applicants for Health and Social Services Community Leadership Bursaries for the 2022-2023 academic year. This program provides financial incentive to students from selected Quebec regions with English and French language skills pursuing full-time studies in the area of health and social services in a government recognized educational institution. Depending on the level of studies (university, college, or vocational) and whether or not the applicants are pursuing their post-secondary studies inside or outside their region, the amount of the bursary may vary between \$2,500 and \$10,000 for the 2022-2023 academic year.

MCF BURSARY PROGRAM FOR ASJ GRADUATES AND ADULT LEARNERS




For the 13th year running, the Megantic Community Foundation (MCF) is pleased to offer three (3) \$500 bursaries:
