## Health and Social Services Community Leadership Bursary Program

### CATEGORY 1 AND CATEGORY 2 BURSARY

#### Purpose

Provide financial incentive to students from selected Quebec regions (see below on right) with appropriate English and French language skills, pursuing full-time studies in the area of health and social services **outside their region (Category 1)** or **within their region (Category 2)** in a government recognized educational institution.

#### Bursary Recipient Commitment

For each bursary awarded, bursary recipients must commit to working in his or her home region following successful completion of studies to work for a minimum of one year in a public health and social services institution or related organization.

#### Bursary Amounts for Category 1

The Program will allocate a total of \$160,000 in bursaries for Category 1 for the academic year 2019-2020.

- University: \$10,000 per student
- Cegep/college: \$5,000 per student

#### Bursary Amounts for Category 2

The Program will allocate a total of \$40,000 in bursaries for Category 2 for the academic year 2019-2020

- University: \$5,000 per student
- Cegep/college: \$2,500 per student

#### To Apply for Academic Year 2019-2020

Students who wish to apply for a bursary for academic year 2019-2020 must submit the requested application forms to **the contact person of the participating community network of their region**. The Directory of Participating Community Networks is included in the Application Guide.

### CATEGORY 3 BURSARY

#### Purpose

Provide financial incentive to students from selected Quebec regions (see below on right) with appropriate English and French language skills, pursuing full-time studies in the area of health and social services **within their region** in a government recognized vocational centre.

#### Bursary Recipient Commitment

For each bursary awarded, bursary recipients must commit to working in his or her home region following successful completion of studies to work for a minimum of one year in a public health and social services institution or related organization.

#### Bursary Amounts for Category 3

The Program will allocate a total of \$20,000 in bursaries for Category 3 for the academic year 2019-2020.

- Secondary vocational training: 2,000\$ per student

#### To Apply for Academic Year 2019-2020

Students who wish to apply for a bursary for academic year 2019-2020 must submit the requested application forms to **the contact person of the participating community network of their region**. The Directory of Participating Community Networks is included in the Application Guide.
